

Play an Anglo Saxon Game!

What you will need:

2 people

A pen and paper

Maybe a ruler to draw straight lines

4 tokens/stones in one colour (you can use anything)

Another 4 tokens/stones in a different colour

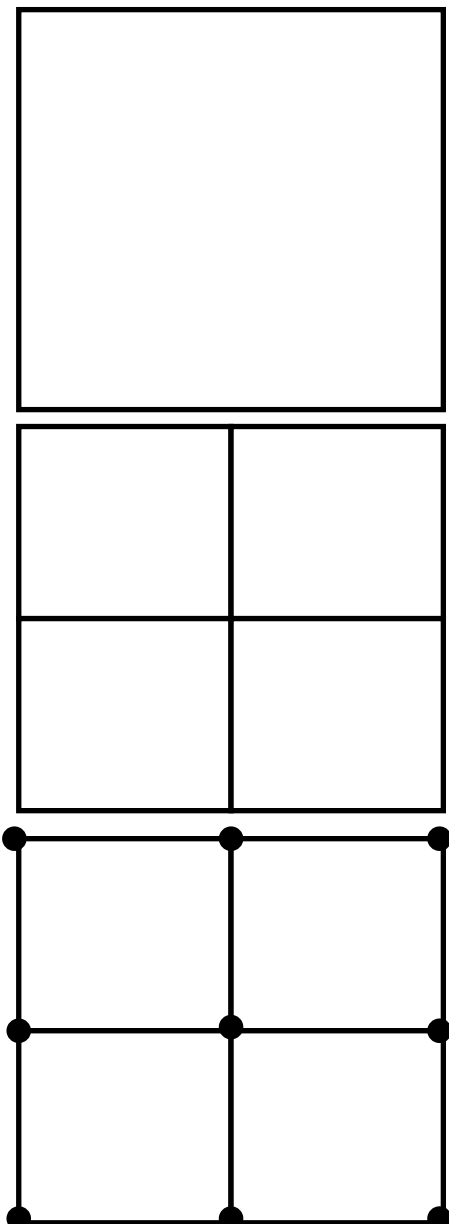
The game is called Three Men's Morris and is similar to modern day noughts and crosses. It is over 3000 year old!

Draw your board.

Step 1: Draw a square on your piece of paper.

Step 2: draw two more lines to make a cross in the middle.

Step 3: Draw dots where the lines meet.



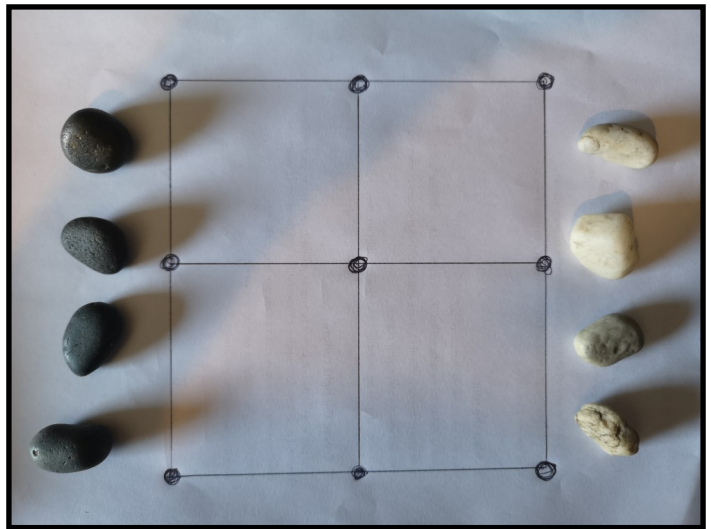

How to play:

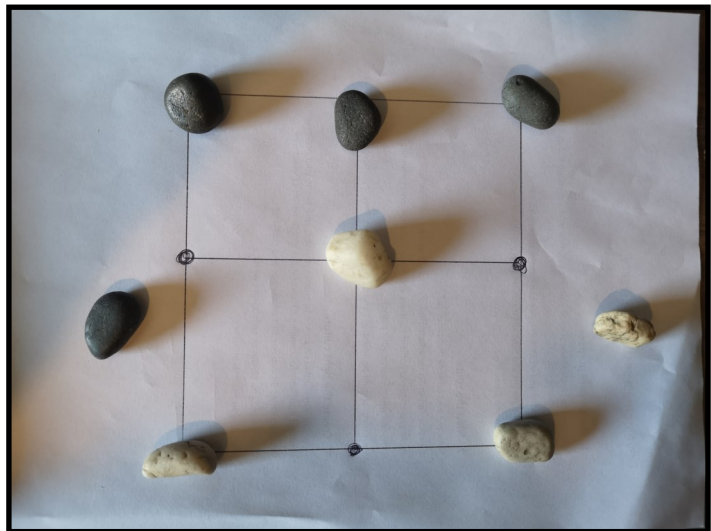
It's played just like noughts and crosses.

Take turns to put stones on the dots of the board. Someone wins if they get 3 in a row.

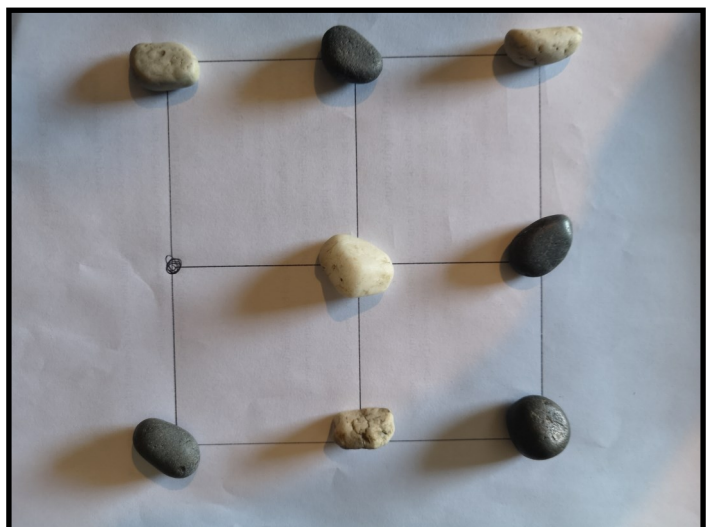
However if all the stones have been placed and no one has won, players carry on playing but instead of placing a stone they must move any one of their stones into the empty space on the board. Play continues with each player moving one token until someone gets 3 in a row.

Once all tokens have been placed players must move one stone a turn until someone wins
