Ely in Cambridgeshire is famous for eels! Did you know that it is thought all European eels spawn in the Sargasso Sea and then return to European waters. The island of Bermuda is the only land mass located inside this vast sea. Can you find Bermuda on the map?



There are 3 rivers that run through Cardiff, the capital of Wales, the Ely, Taff & the Rhymney. These rivers are 24, 40 & 30 miles long. The Great Ouse in Cambridgeshire is 143 miles long. How much longer is the Great Ouse? Choose an action, like a star jump, & repeat it this many times! What action will you choose?



The koala is Queensland's state animal. If you had to choose an animal to represent Ely, other than an eel, what would you pick? It could be real or mythical! Draw, or design your own.



There are 8 places called Ely in the United States of America. Some are in typically warm, sunny states and others can be very cold! Imagine you are visiting each Ely & choose just 8 things to take with you - what will you pick?
