


# CREATE YOUR OWN PREHISTORIC CREATURES

My prehistoric creature is called a:

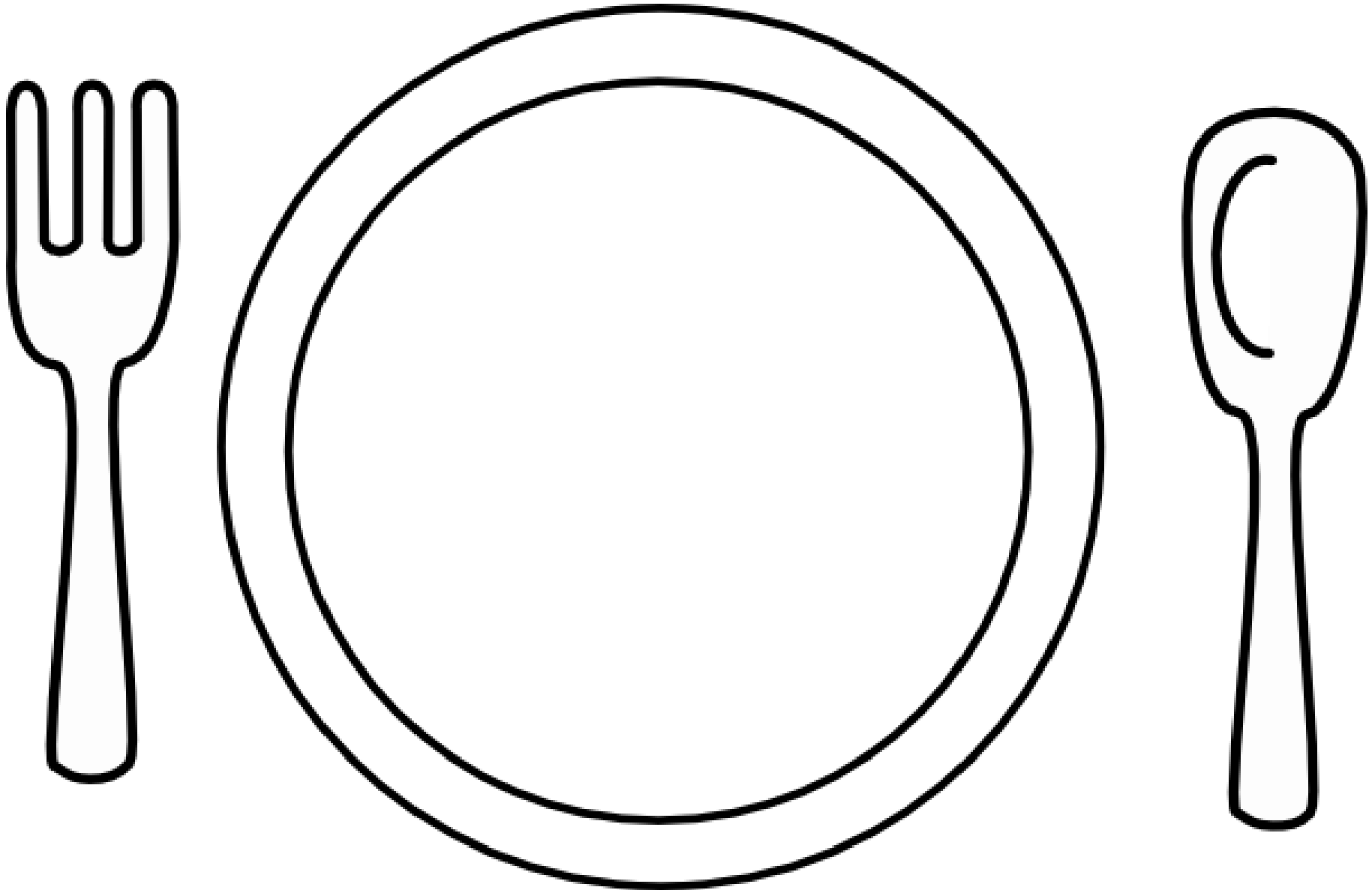

Will it eat lots of small creatures or plants or fewer large things?

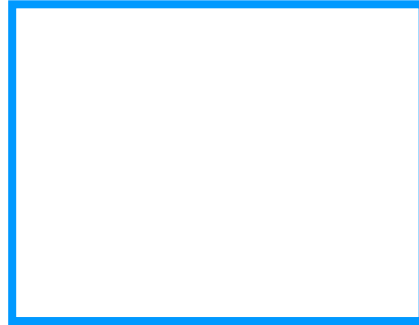
Draw or describe its dinner on the plate!



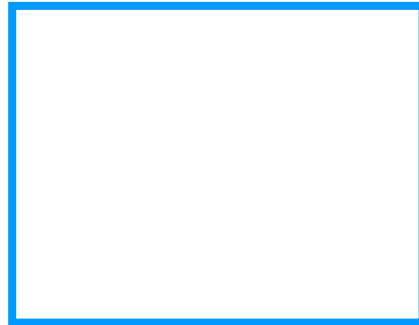
Where is your prehistoric creature in the food chain?  
A food chain shows how plants and animals get their energy. Draw or write them in the boxes

Design a habitat for your prehistoric creature!  
What will you include?

A food chain always starts with a **producer**. This is an organism that makes its own food. Most food chains start with a green plant, because plants can make their food.



A living thing that eats other plants and animals is called a **consumer**.



A predator is an animal that eats other animals. The animals that predators eat are called **prey**. Predators are found at the **top** of a food chain.
