

Write a DRAGON story

Dragons have featured in stories for thousands of years. From stories written by ancient Greek and Roman people to modern authors like J K Rowling who features dragons in Harry Potter and Cressida Cowell's How to Train your Dragon series. Many dragons are portrayed as scary monsters, but others are friendly!

Have a go at writing your own story, featuring a dragon. You could write a short story on one page or write a longer story over several pages. You could also draw illustrations for your story or ask an adult to help you write it down.

Here are some things you could include in your story:

A description of your dragon.

Remember to include lots of descriptive words to share what your dragon looks like and how it behaves. What texture is its skin? What noises does it make? How does it move?

When and where is your story set?

Where in the world does your story take place? Remember to describe it too. Perhaps it takes place hundreds of years ago in ancient China, a medieval English village or in modern day Ely!

Who is your story about?

Is your story just about dragons or does it include people & other creatures or animals too?

What happens in your story?

Remember to give your story a beginning, middle and end to keep your reader interested!
