

Birthday Partys at Ely Museum FAQ

1. How long do I have the party room for?

You have the exclusive use of the party room for 2 hours. The first hour is hosted by a member of the museum team and the second hour is just for you. Further hosted time is available at additional cost, please see the booking form.

2. Can we bring a Birthday cake?

Yes, you can bring a birthday cake and party food but this must only be consumed in the party room and not the museum galleries. Candles and knives must be supervised by a responsible adult.

3. Can we decorate the room?

Ely museum provides some themed decorations and a projected backdrop on one wall. There is space for guests to secure a banner along one wall and you are welcome to bring free-standing decorations.

4. Can we come early to set up?

You may arrive 20min before the party start time to set up.

5. Where can we park?

The museum does not have its own parking but there are many places to park for free in Ely. The council offices car park is the closest, but restrictions may apply, all parking is at your own risk.

6. Is the party room fully accessible?

There is step free access from the road and throughout Ely Museum. There is a fully enclosed lift to the second floor and an accessible toilet on the ground floor. If you require any additional adaptations, please get in contact.
